remotely from home, coming to the company as-needed.
Field operations staff remained working on site. We are
fortunate and thankful for our dedicated employees.
They kept the company operating without interruption.
So for the year, water production increased by
8.2 percent, and we attribute this increase to mostly
due to COVID-19.
Water quality samples were regularly taken
throughout 2020. All samplings met Federal and State
health standards.
Basin watermaster costs for the 2020 fiscal
year totaled \$923,861.
Water table variation, the key, the Baldwin
Park Key Well is the water table measuring baseline.
With the rainfall we have had since the beginning of the
fiscal year 2019-20, the water table is at 197.5 feet as
of March 2021. However, it is 11 feet below the same
period last year. So we're still in a drought
condition, if you will.
Los Angeles County property taxes for 2020, we
paid \$18,907.
Insurance costs for 2020 were \$245,695.
Power costs for 2020 were \$469,225. That's
reflecting an increase of 16 percent from the previous

We have some accomplishments in 2020. I would like to mention them.

Sunny Slope continued to purchase cyclic water when available. We purchased 1,000 acre-feet of cyclic water for storage. Cyclic water will offset rising replenishment water costs.

This year we made a conversion from bimonthly to monthly billing. Customer billing was successfully converted to monthly billing beginning with bills generated on November 1st, 2020. This conversion improved the billing process, promoted consistent bill receivables every month, and provided the capability to bill for water consumption in a timely manner.

Automated accounts payable implementation.

This implementation improved the company's procure-to-pay (P2P) process with the implementation of the Sage APA system. This led to many end-to-end business process improvements and efficiencies within the procurement, purchase order, invoice, and payment life cycle, including, but not limited to, documents stored in a central repository, approval workflow, reporting, transparency, and auditability.

We installed a new fence at the Duarte Pump

House. The fence included an automated gate. This new

fence provides physical access and security. It also

1 improved the aesthetics of the location. 2 As you may be aware, office remodel after 3 satisfying necessary permit applications and construction bid process, construction activities began 4 in December 2020. We expect this construction to be 5 6 completed by the end of July this year. 7 Reservoir 1 rehabilitation project. Initial engineering evaluation and assessment was conducted in 8 9 the third quarter of last year. The engineering 10 specifications and plans have been completed. We are now preparing to go out for construction bids. 11 12 And lastly, EPA vulnerability assessment and resiliency project. This project is to comply with the 13 14 EPA Title II Americas Water Infrastructure Act. entails two phases: first, risk and resilience 15 assessment, which was completed; and second, emergency 16 17 response plan, which is work in progress this year. 18 That concludes my report, Mr. President. 19 MR.
